Mr. Sun has dedicated himself to the stenography industry for decades and has established the largest stenography training school in China.

Thousands of outstanding stenographers have graduated from the school that he established and many of them have won both national and international awards.

Two such winners include Wang Lu and Wang Xiubo. These champions of the international and national stenography competitions are both graduates of Mr. Sun's school.

Mr. Sun has also made outstanding contributions to the cultivation of Chinese stenographers. He has led the research and development of many stenographic teaching methods throughout the past decade. These include the “Production-line” and “Five Elements” teaching methods, which are well known throughout China. Not content to rest on his laurels, last year Mr. Sun successfully launched a stenographer standardization training scheme called the *Tower Type Teaching Model*. This solution has become the single unified

standard among Chinese stenography training centers and has been approved by the authority of the stenography industry, Mr. Tang Yawei. Mr. Tang Yawei has required that all stenography training centers implement this solution.

Mr. Sun has made tremendous long term efforts and contributions to the development and expansion of the stenographic industry and has tirelessly worked to promote and popularize the profession to China's 1.3 billion people. He also pushed forward government efforts to open a national stenography certification testing center and was personally appointed to its Directorship. The very first stenographer certification accredited by the Chinese national government was issued by Mr. Sun.

In order to train more professional stenographers, Mr. Sun helped build the first facilities for the research and development of stenographic training methods and has unselfishly continued to share the methods he has developed and put into practice with all of the other stenographic training centers nationwide. He also leads the 47th International Stenographic Conference and Competition. Mr. Sun did this as a way to attract more attention from the national government to the industry. He not only succeeded but earned the commendation of the Chinese government. His contributions have made government offices, media outlets, and professional enterprises better understand the importance of stenography to improving the efficiency of the modern office. Each year, Mr. Sun's company provides stenographic services to hundreds of companies throughout the country.

Even more inspiring is that in order to develop more stenographers, Mr. Sun tirelessly makes himself available to students and youth by giving free public lectures. Since 2003, Mr. Sun has used

almost all of his free time to deliver more than 700 public lectures. Today his lectures have grown to average over a hundred attendees and overall more than 100 thousand people have learned about the magic of stenography from Mr. Sun's personal efforts.
