TEXT AND INFORMATION PROCESSING: processing texts and text related data for communication purposes

<u>SECRETARIAT:</u> the professional skills needed by all persons having a secretarial function



















INTERSTENO AIMS TO PROVIDE AN INTERNATIONAL FORUM FOR INFORMATION PROCESSING

- a. to organize world championships and other international contests in its domains of activity;
- b. to associate people in all countries occupying themselves with one or more of the domains of activity of the Federation;
- c. to encourage the maintenance of high standards of competence and performance;
- d. to promote the use of new technologies and proper technical research
- e. to co-operate with national and local governments, non governmental organizations or international public and private agencies
- f. to collect and to spread information including information in cooperation with local governments, public institutions and private companies;
- g. to organize congresses and conferences;
- h. to advance joint studies concerning its domains of activity;
- i. to defend the professional interests

The aim of IPRS is to enable parliamentary reporters to co-operate via a professional organization for improving the services they provide to parliaments


