The Organizing Committee is putting the final touches needed to create a perfect Congress that will conclude a long series of Intersteno Congresses held in Europe. In 2009 the new Congress will be in Pekin (China).

The Vice President of the Chamber of Deputies of the Czech Republic, **Jan Kasal** assumed the patronage of our Congress and sent this letter to the Organizing Committee:

I am pleased to assume the patronage of the World Championships in Information Processing associated with the International Congress of Intersteno 2007. Due to the extraordinary success of our representatives at the last world championship Prague acquired the privilege of arranging the contest after more than 40 years. Competitions will certify abilities in

- o Text production
- o Text correction
- o Professional Word processing
- o Steno/Speech capturing
- o Realtime speech capturing
- Correspondence and minute taking
- Steno/Speech capturing in several languages

Special attention will be given to **disabled people**, for whom **separate classifications lists will be issued**.

#### Competitions rules

A new document has been prepared, which includes all kind of competitions and contains **important differences from past competitions.** Competitors are strongly recommended <u>to read it now</u>. This document is available in English, French and German on our traditional web sites.

### • Which topics will be covered in the lectures?

They will be coordinated by Mark Golden(USA) as follows:

**Session 1 (afternoon of 23 July)** will focus on the technology and technical capabilities and limitations of capturing words and processing text (including everything from written shorthand to text entry to stenographic shorthand and voice recognition).

Session 2 (morning of 24 July) will cover applications or uses of the technology in different environments, and the social/economic value of the profession
