50 years of 'new' Intersteno




50 years ago, Marcel Racine invited representatives of many European countries to meet at Mont Pelerin, a wonderful place on the hills of Vevey (Switzerland).

From there, one has a magnificent view not only on the lake of Geneva, but on the highest summits of the Alps mountains.

From this meeting, maybe with the inspiration of this magnificent view, Intersteno was brought to a new life, after the forced pause due to the II World war. Notwhistanding the big problems existing in that moment in many European countries, the faith in a better future prevailed and Intersteno people will be proud to celebrate in Wien also the 50th anniversary of the first keyboarding world championship, which took place the following year in Monaco-Montecarlo together with the new start of the Intersteno Congresses.

The Austrian Group of Intersteno

The 45th Intersteno Congress is organised by the Austrian Intersteno Group, which is an important part of the huge activity of **OSTV** - **Österreichisher Verband für Stenografie und Textverarbeitung** i.e. Austrian Association for Steno and text processing.





If the number of participants in steno competitions has unfortunately decreased in the last years due to the elimination of shorthand teaching in public schools, competitors in keyboarding competitions **has gone up till 12.000.** In the last 4 years competitions of this kind took place also with the support of Internet.

Training is made with the aid of computers, all members receive a monthly review and updated information is made available on www.ostv.at web site.

The activity of the Austrian Group is well known all over Europe, since each year (and for more than 20 years now) a **Youth meeting is organized with keyboarding competition**. This event is supported by the Municipality of Wien and is attended by about 50 persons coming from different European countries.

Sad news - Friedrich Baumgartner (A) passed away on the 21st of January.

Our President, Missis Marlis Kulb informes that **Mr. Friedrich Baumgartner** passed away on 21st January 2005, after a long period of illness, in the age of 75 years.

Mr. Baumgartner represented during many years the Austrian National Group in the Intersteno Central Committee. In the years 70, he took the heavy duty and responsibility of jury president in the world championships typewriting.

After he retired from Intersteno, about 10 years ago, he was still active in the Austrian Association, where many of us had the opportunity to meet him. Mr. Baumgartner was the 'inventor' in 1985 of dictations for steno training via telephone, and has continuosly followed this activity.
